Fencing-Esgrime NB, in conjunction with Barbara Daniel as learning facilitator, is offering both workshops of the Instructor Beginner coaching stream. People interested in coaching fencing at a club level will find both workshops invaluable for the development and refinement of their coaching skills, as well as an important step towards certification. Participants may take only one of these workshops if they wish, but participation in both is recommended.

Workshop 1

This workshop provides an overview of the core NCCP coaching competencies as well as the essentials of working with groups of fencers. It includes work on planning and teaching a fencing practice using the technical-tactical skills of the yellow armband, giving feedback, and developing basic refereeing skills.

Workshop 2

STORM DATE: Feb. 16 (Sun) 9 am to 6 pm

This workshop is primarily focused on one-on-one interactions between coaches and fencers. It includes work on individual demonstrations, mini-lessons using the technical & tactical elements of the yellow and orange armband skills.

Eligibility: These workshops are open to participants who are 16+ years of age.

Coach-candidates under the age of 18 can achieve NCCP Trained status, but must be 18 years or older to achieve certification and to coach independently. Younger coaches should work under the supervision of a certified coach who is at least 18 years old.

What to bring: Participants should wear athletic clothing, bring their fencing equipment, water bottle, pen, notebook and have a lunch for each day.
